

Rent a Boat

The Seychelles Archipelago, rightly considered the jewel of the Indian Ocean, contains 115 islands of which about a dozen may be visited.

Some are served by a regular air service, while all may be reached by boat. The boats are of course of the ocean-going type, equipped for the depths and climate of the ocean.

There is nothing more desirable than cruising in Seychelles: you can go where you wish, anchoring when you want.

You can visit unpolluted sites, discovering the enchanting beauty of the local fauna and flora. You can try your hand at deep-sea fishing, or snorkelling to discover the coralline seabed, the ideal habitat of an incredible number and variety of tropical fish.

This is a rather expensive type of trip, but becomes quite acceptable when shared between a number of passengers.

The choice and variety of boats available in Seychelles is large: from luxurious yachts to catamarans, from sailing boats to the local wooden schooners.
