

4TH ITINERARY:**North Mahé**

Starting from Victoria, take Revolution Avenue and after about 4km you will reach the beach of **Beau Vallon**, the most popular on the island, equipped for all water sports, including paragliding.

Daily excursions with glass-bottomed boats for visiting the Marine Park of **Cap Ternay** are organized daily by the Coral Strand and Berjaya Beau Vallon Bay Hotels. We warmly suggest this excursion especially for the great quantity of fish to be seen. The excursion can be made in half a day. Continuing along the road north of Beau Vallon, you reach Glacis, with its luxurious villas overlooking the sea. Go on then to North Point, Carana Beach, Anse Etoile, and back to Victoria.

**5TH ITINERARY:****South Mahé**

Starting from Anse Aux Pins, where you can visit the **Craft Village** and the **Creole House**, continue to La Plaine, where the craft factory, **La Marine**, is located. It produces wooden naval models. Continuing along the road, you come to **Anse Royale**, with its splendid beach. In front of the church take the Les Canelles road that leads to **Anse à la Mouche**. Along the way we suggest you visit Le **Jardin du Roi**, with its spices plantation and the studio of the sculptor Tom Bowers. Continuing for **Baie Lazare**, **Anse Gaulette** and **Anse Takamaka**, one of the most beautiful beaches on the island, you will arrive at Quatre Bornes. Here, at the crossroads, turn right in the direction of **Anse Intendance**, a vast and splendid beach that you must not miss. Continuing along the main road, you will finally get to Police Bay.
